

Adobe Flash Player End-of-Life

Technical Bulletin (TB210112A)

Applicable Models

- KMC TotalControl
- BAC-A1616BC (Building Controller)

Situation

Effective January 12, 2021, Adobe blocks Flash Player from running.

Adobe Flash player is now End Of Life (EOL). This means Adobe does not intend to issue Flash Player updates or security patches. Therefore, Adobe will continue to prompt users to uninstall Flash Player and strongly recommends that all users immediately uninstall Flash Player. Major browser vendors disabled Flash Player from running after the EOL date.

Solutions

Although web access to the system will be impacted, these systems will still function properly on-site. You can still access these systems using the KMC software tools KMC Connect and KMC TotalControl Design Studio.

TotalControl

Starting in TotalControl version 4.5, TotalControl Web Portal offers the ability to publish existing graphical pages and create new graphical pages that will publish as HTML5 pages. Previous versions of TotalControl Web Portal must be upgraded to TotalControl 4.5 in order for HTML5 publishing to be available.

BAC-A1616BC (Building Controller)

The BAC-A1616BC will continue to publish pages in Flash only. Solutions for page rendering in HTML5 include:

- · migrating web viewing to TotalControl 4.5 server for viewing and access; or,
- migrating web viewing to another on-site hardware platform capable of serving HTML5 pages such as a KMC
 Commander or JACE 8000 series controller.
